We will have a tour to the trulli limestone dwellings found in the southern region of Puglia, are remarkable examples of drywall (mortarless) construction, a prehistoric building technique still in use in this region. The trulli are made of roughly worked limestone boulders collected from neighbouring fields. Temp High 26

Argostoli is the beautiful capital of Kefalonia, the largest of the Ionian Islands in western Greece. Argostoli has modernized comforts and preserved Grecian beauty that allows the city to be highly accessible to visitors while not feeling like a tourist town. Excellent attractions such as the Koutavos lagoon, a well-known bird sanctuary.

The primary economy is tourism. Burano is 7 kilometres from Venice, a 45-minute trip from St. Mark's Square by vaporetto, a Venetian water bus.

It is one of I Borghi più belli d'Italia ("The most beautiful villages of Italy").

You can walk to the centre of Asolo and its Cathedral in 5 minutes.
